**TMT Investments PLC wins Venture Awards Russia's 'Exit of the Year' Award**

TMT Investments PLC, which invests in high-growth, internet-based companies across a variety of sectors and is listed on the AIM market of the London Stock Exchange, recently received an award for its investment exit from Astrid. In May 2013, Yahoo acquired Astrid, which was an automated personal assistant that helps people manage their "to-do" lists on the iPhone, Android, and the Web by connecting them to people and products to help them get things done. A year after its initial investment in Astrid, TMT Investments PLC made a successful exit to Yahoo resulting in an IRR of up to 57%.

The award ceremony, held in Moscow on 5 December, honours Russia-based international venture capital companies, Russian venture capital companies and leading investors. The event was hosted by RusBase and Firma, and supported by PwC, the Russian Venture Company (RVC) and RosBusinessConsulting (RBC).

Alexander Selegenev, TMT's Executive Director, commented: "TMT is pleased to receive this award, as it shows how borderless the internet investment world is. Our team has a wealth of experience managing and selecting internet-based companies and therefore was able to spot Astrid's uniqueness ahead of Yahoo. Astrid is a true example of a high quality internet company, as it had a proven growth history and large market opportunities. At the time of the investment, Astrid had highly competent and motivated management, as well as huge growth potential. Such factors are essential when TMT considers an investment opportunity."

Prior to investing US\$400,000 in April 2012, Astrid for Android had already been downloaded over 3 million times, and had over 25,000 5-star ratings. Astrid's web application was named one of the Top 20 Browser Apps of 2011 by PC World, and Astrid's iPhone application was named an "Essential App" by Gizmodo in November 2011.

Although a large proportion of TMT's investments are currently in Silicon Valley companies, TMT invests globally. The management team at TMT previously led RBC, one of Russia's leading media and internet companies, which conducted Russia's first successful IPO on MICEX.
